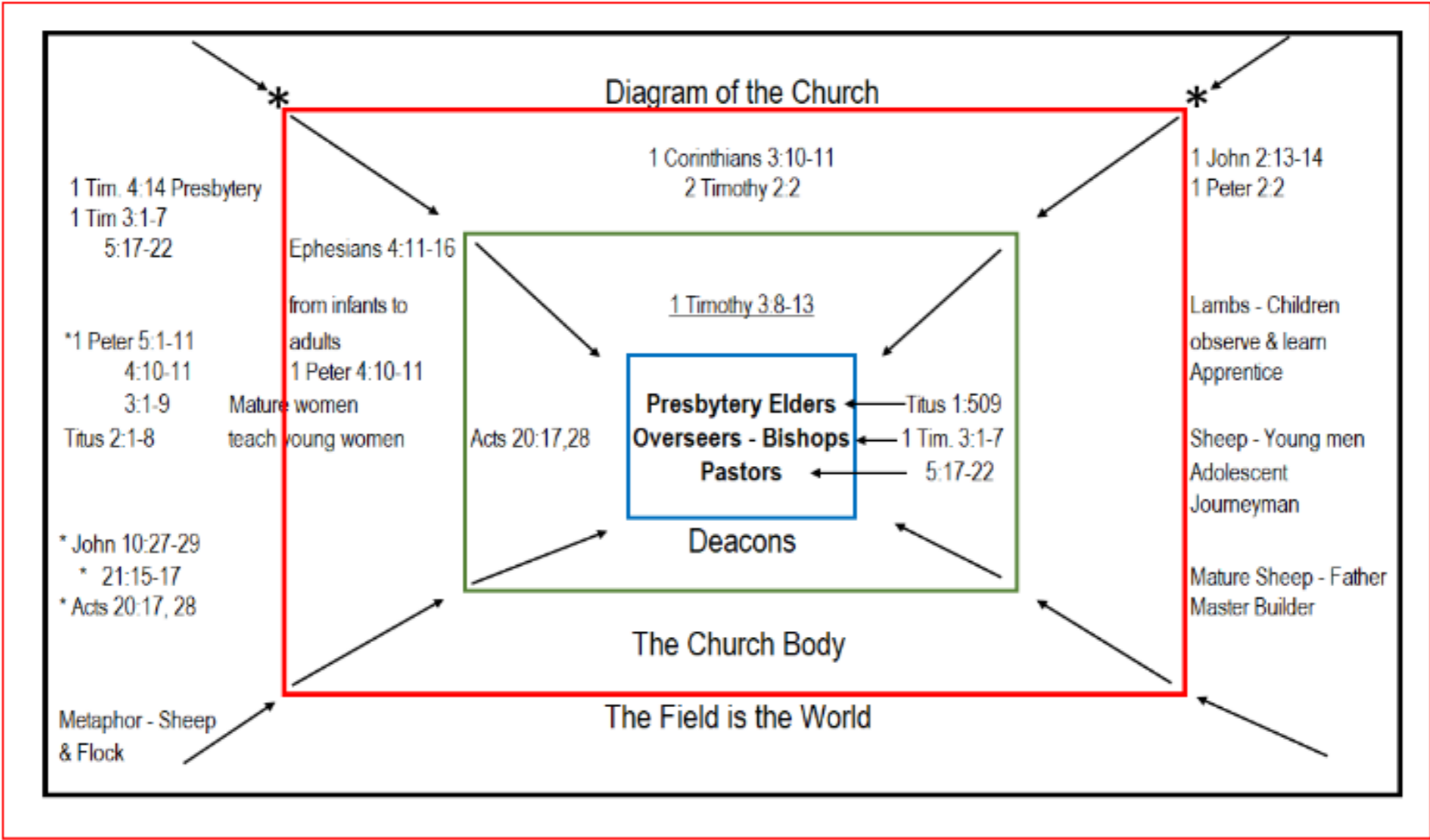
# Four Gospels

## Two Key Ingredients

1. God's Grace - Genesis 6:8
2. Man's Faith - Hebrews 11

1. Gospel of the Kingdom of heaven/physical Kingdom: Matt 3:1-2,11, 4:17, 23, 10:5-7, Acts 2:37-38, Gal. 2:7-9
2. Gospel of Grace: Acts 16:30-31, Rom. 10:9-13, Eph. 2:8-9, Titus 3:3-7
3. Gospel of the Kingdom 2.0: Matt. 24:13-14, Rev. 12:17, 14:12 Eph. 4:30
4. The Everlasting Gospel: Rev. 14:6-7 (Romans 1:18-25) Rev. 14:1-20: Furlong = 600 feet X 1,600 = 182 miles

# Trans-dispensational Truth

## All truth is not necessarily dispensational truth.

- **Universal Truth transcends all dispensations. It is information that is helpful for me that is not dispensational attached. All the BIBLE was written for our learning, but not all about us, or to us.**
- **We compare similar scriptures, and contrast dissimilar scriptures.**
- **EXAMPLE: Matthew 6:14-15 - For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:  
15 But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.**

**CONTRAST: Ephesians 4:32 - 32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.**

**Colossians 2:13-15 - 13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;**

**\*Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;**

**15 And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.**

**COMPARE: Titus 2:11-14 - 11 For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, 12 Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; 13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ; 14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.**

**1 Peter 2:9-10 - • But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light;**

**10 Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.**

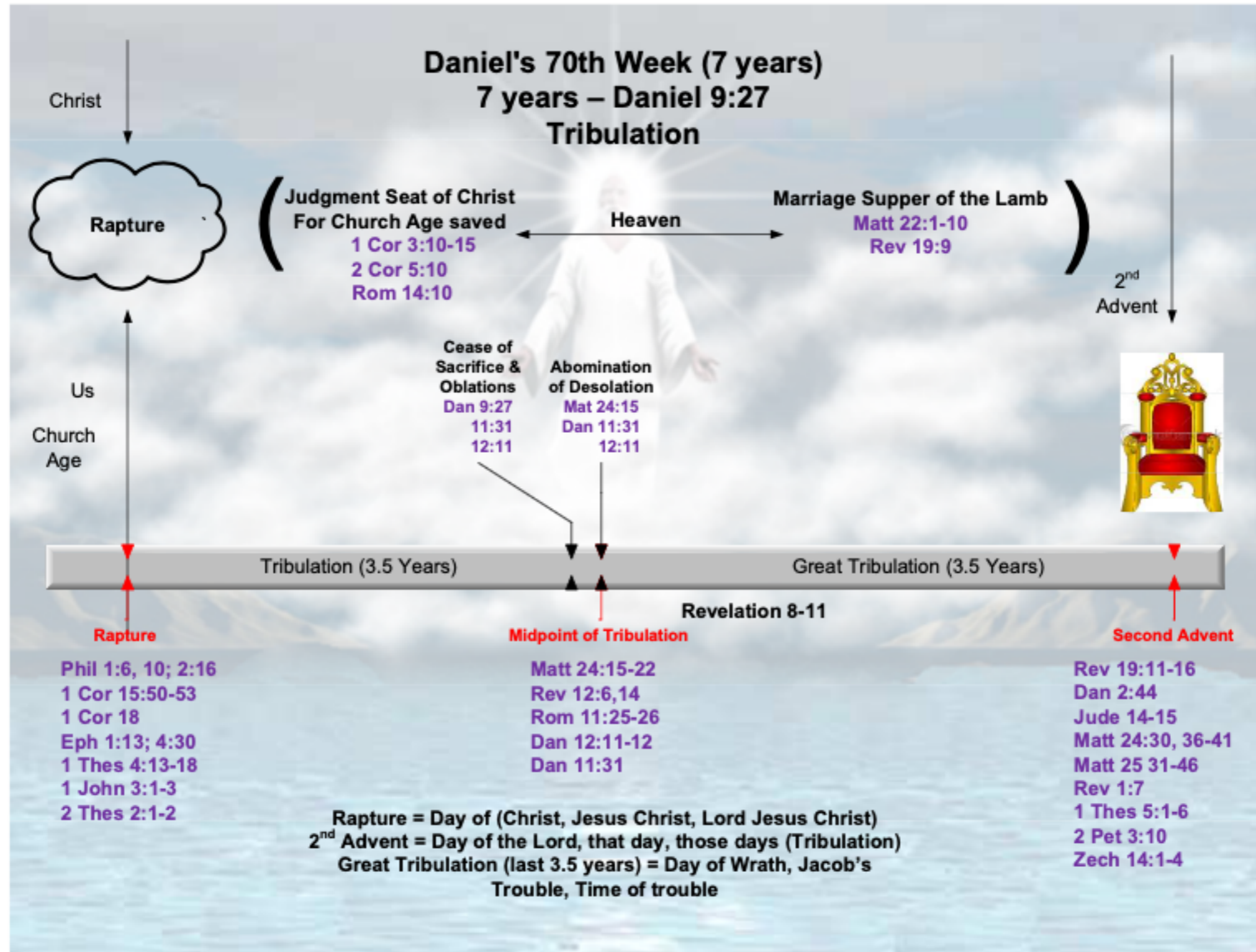

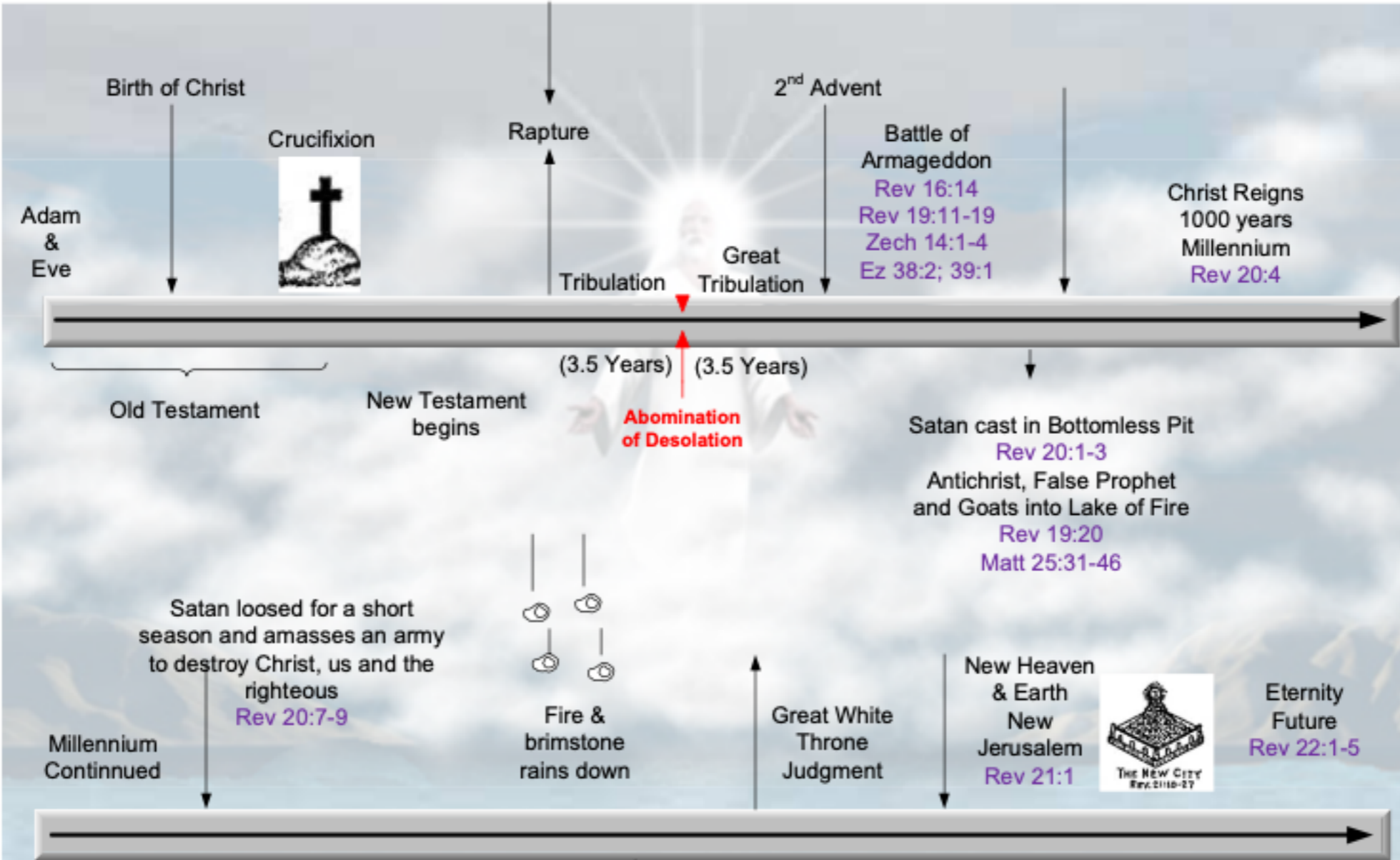




# Daniel's 70th week



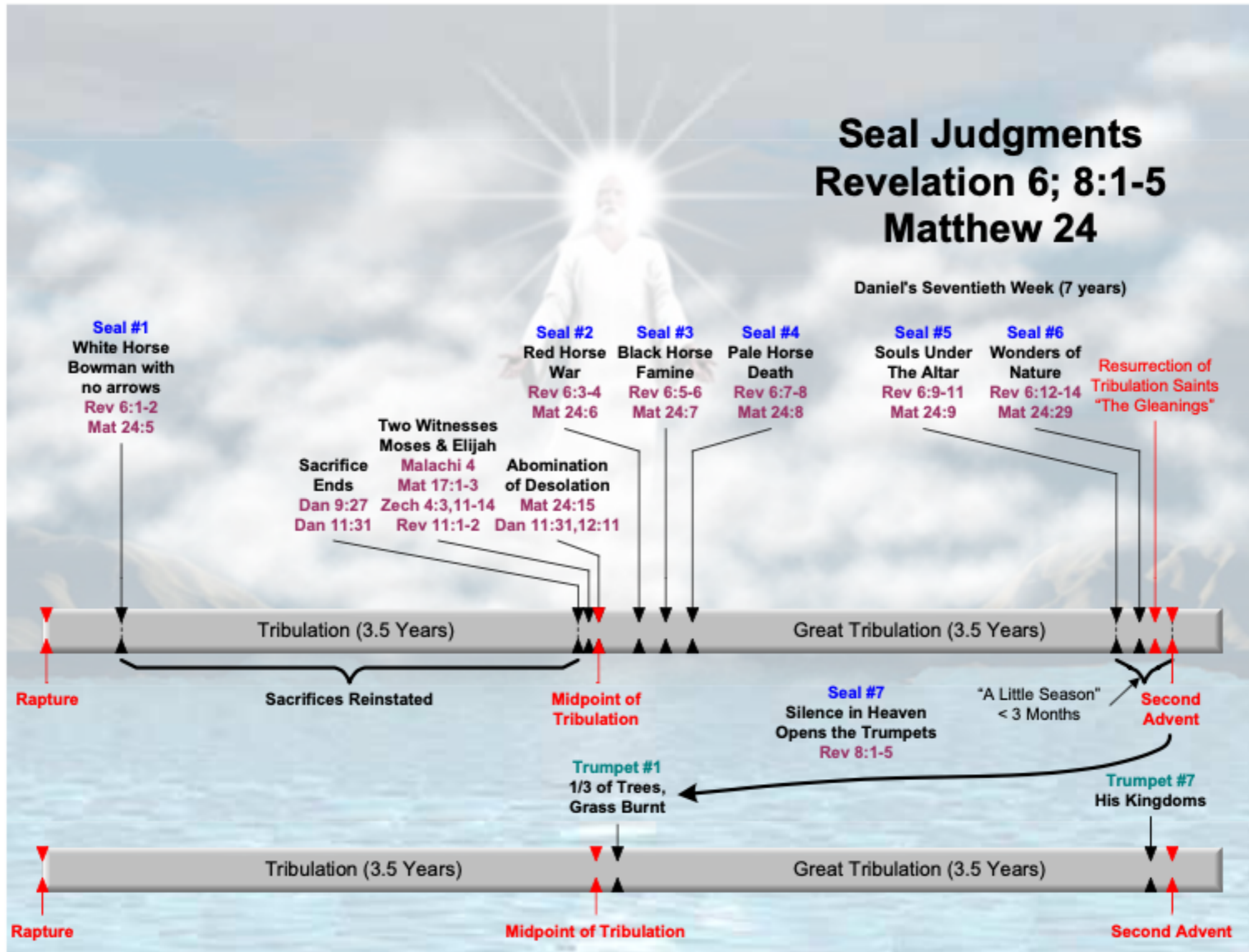
# Man's Timeline



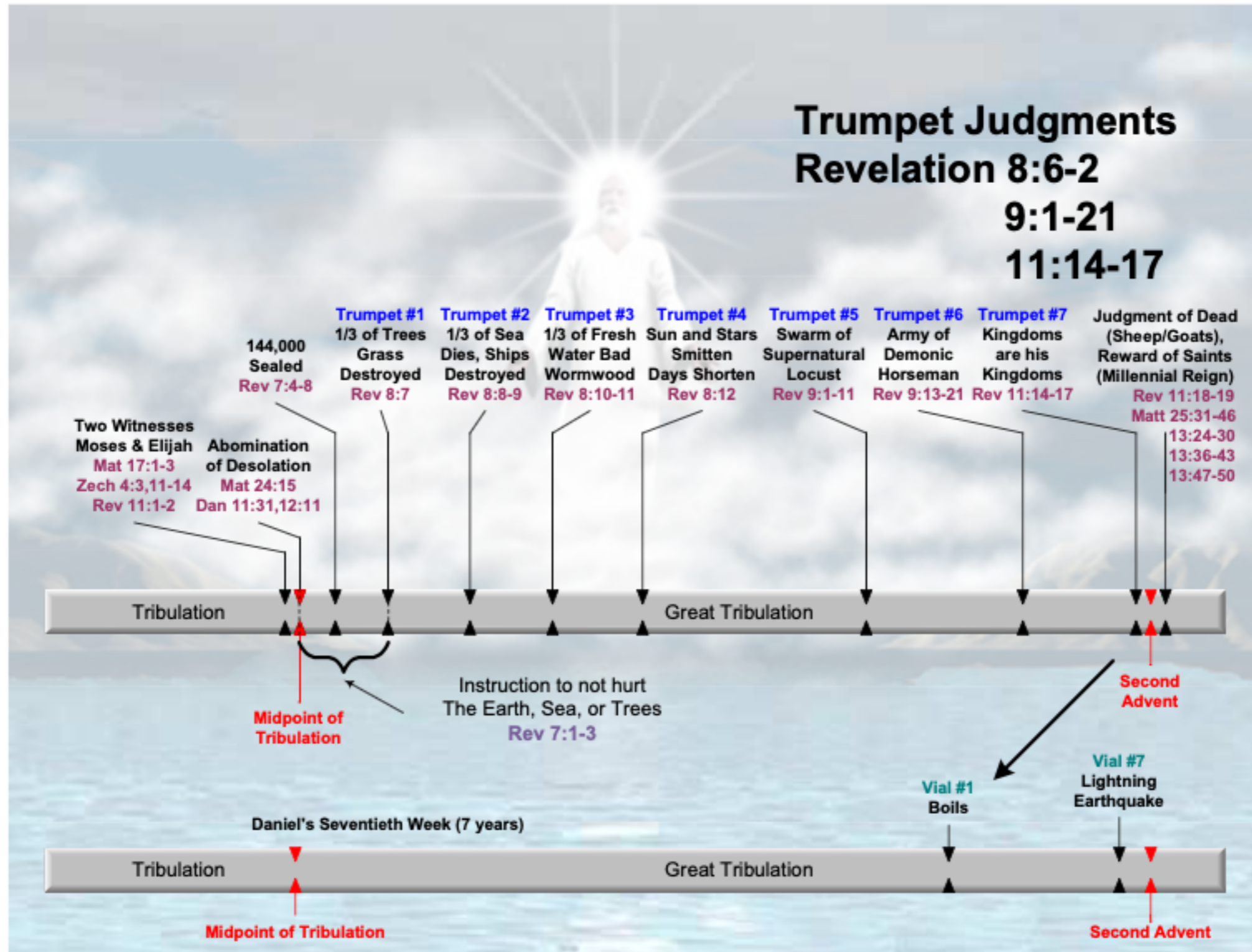
**Time Line of Man**
